Created in 1949 at the Lincoln Grill, a restaurant founded by Richard and Nancy Inouye in old downtown Hilo, Hawai'i right across from the still active Lincoln Park at the corner of Kino'ole and Ponahawai streets - this culinary masterpiece, was the favorite of the old Hilo athletic club known as the Lincoln Wreckers. The Wreckers were known for their exploits in the popular "bare-foot" football league. The nuttiest player on the Wreckers (a.k.a. Loco) asked the Inouye's to create something that was tasty, yet filling and Dan-Dan-Ta-Daaaannnn. . . . something uniquely representing the mishmash of the local Hawaiian cultures was born, the LOCO MOCO — after its namesake. The Lincoln Grill is gone, but nearly 60 years later, the Loco Moco is here to stay.

In celebration of the soon to be 60th anniversary of this gastronomic juggernaut from the 50th state, we here at the Hukilau, would like to expand on Loco's simple request to make something tasty, yet filling, and we are

Forget the gravy, our friends south of the border like to top their rice, patties and egg with Hukilau Chili, cheese, onions and a touch of our own special jalapeno sauce. . . muy bueno! *(best with Corona and a shot of Patron)*

Like climbing Mauna Kea or catching tube at Pipeline, eat this only if you have the GUTS. We celebrate Sixty Years with our traditional Loco Moco, built up with 3-scoops rice, two hamburger patties, two fried eggs and then we ADD two slices of delicately grilled Spam, two strips of bacon, a few slices of grilled Portuguese sausage for good measure, our Hukilau gravy and a side of Kim Chee just to ensure we make Loco proud. *(best with a 1967 Lafite — but cuz we don't have it, we recommend a Bud-lite)*
